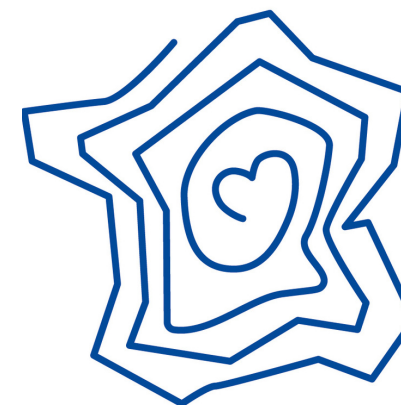


TEACH WITH THE TAPIF

No need to be sponsored by an employer! You will need to prove your business viability.

* pathways to THE FRENCH CITIZENSHIP

An EU passport is a door opener to a stable stay in France. The options marked with a * are counted towards the French nationality application.

GET A JOB* BEFORE ARRIVING

An ideal option to relocate. You will have more chances if your current employer already has branches in France or if you have a good network in France (and eventually speak French).

MARRY YOUR FRENCH PARTNER*

The Vie Privée et Familiale visa (French spouse visa) should be renewed for the first 3 years before requesting the 10-year residence permit or request the French nationality after 4 years of marriage.

(BACK TO) STUDIES*

Studying in France will give you better access to the French job market. It is a good opportunity to change career or make a specialisation.

A one-year job search/business creation visa is granted once graduated.
